2023 SCHOOL PROFILE

Colégio Santo Américo was founded on February 27th, 1951, by Benedictine Hungarian monks. It is a traditional school, widely recognized by its academic standards, Christian values and by its highly competitive sports teams.

The school covers 17 years of education, 5 years in kindergarten, 5 years in Primary School, 4 years in Elementary School, and 3 years in High School.

American High School Program

Students can also choose to take an American High School program, from Andrew's University and have a dual diploma at the end of their Brazilian High School period. This program enables students to have 6 pre-college credits. (Health/Fine Arts/American Literature/British Literature/American Government/American History/Computers)

Social welfare institutions for children

Colégio Santo Américo runs three social institutes, and students are frequently involved in preparing projects to be shared with children who attend these institutes.

International Examinations

Colégio Santo Américo is a Cambridge English Preparation Center, applying exams to Elementary School (Pre A1 Starters, A1 Movers A2 Flyers Middle School (Key and Preliminary) and High School students (First, Advanced, Proficiency).

The school is also a center that applies the Spanish DELE exams, from Elementary School to High School (A1, A2, B1 and B2).
